The aim of the project is to provide people in Sierra Leone with access to sustainable and protected water supply and sanitary structures as well as to empower them to employ safe WASH practices.

Subgoals to this endeavour are:

1. By the end of the project period, access to improved and sustainable WASH services has been ensured
2. Strengthened WASH structures enable the implementation of climate-resilient and gender-equitable WASH interventions at the district level and raise awareness of the importance of climate-resilient WASH services
3. District WASH Committees strengthen networking and lobbying and influencing national policy on WASH issues

- A copy of valid Business Registration Certificate
- A copy of valid NRA Tax Clearance Certificate
- A copy of a valid NASSIT Clearance Certificate
- Council Registration Certificate
- Audited Monthly Cash Flow Statement for the last 12 months
- A Bid security of fifty thousand Leones (Le196,000) in the new SL currency or its equivalent from a reputable Banking Institution
- Audited Income Statements for the last three years.
- Work schedule
- List of proposed Personnel with their qualification and experience
- List of available Contractor's equipment and their availability, source (lease, rental or owned)& copies of Vehicle registration cards
